

CERTH, as the contractor and the data controller, informs the natural person who signs the written quotation as a bidder or as a legal representative of the bidder, that by itself or third parties, by order and on its behalf, will process the below personal data, as follows:

I. The data processing includes personal data contained in the written quotation and the supporting documents submitted by the natural person, who is the bidder or the legal representative of the bidder, to the contractor in the context of this request for quotation. Indicatively, the processed data could be the identity and contact information of the bidder and any other personal information which is referred to his written quotation and his declaration regarding his non-exclusion according to article 73 of Law 4412/2016, and any other supporting document that may be requested by the contractor in the light of compliance with the applicable public procurement laws.

II. The data processing is necessary for the evaluation of the bidder's quotation, the performance of the procurement procedure, the exercise or defense of legal claims, rights, and interests of CERTH, the fulfillment of its legal obligations, and the general security of transactions. It is noted that the identity and contact information will be used for communication with the bidder regarding the evaluation of his quotation.

III. Recipients of the above data could be:

(a) Bodies that are assigned by CERTH to perform specific actions on its behalf, i.e. its consultants and executives, members of the Evaluation Committees, other agents, etc., provided that, in any case, privacy and confidentiality principles are met.

IV.
